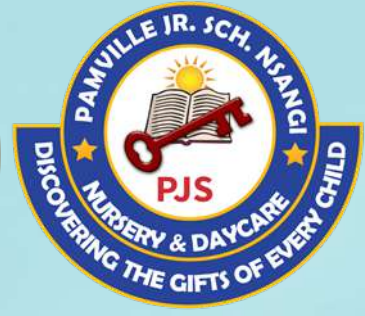

# Pamville Mukuuma Educational Service

## **What is Pamville Mukuuma Education Service?**

This is a child care and support programme founded in 2022 with the major aim of providing total care, support and education to children whose parents are busy working abroad or far away from home.

## **Why is it necessary and for who?**

The reality is that many parents have jobs and work far away from home. They may not be able to resign or leave such jobs because of different reasons. At Pamville Schools Nsangi we realized some of those 'absent parents' are very much disturbed and unsettled, always wondering whom to leave their child or how their children are coping. They are also worried and not sure if their children will continue to

receive quality education and all other necessary forms of care when they are parents are away. The answer to such worries and challenges is the Pamville Mukuuma Education Service.

## **Who are the children targeted for this service?**

The Pamville Mukuuma Education Service targets children aged 3 years to 13 years for 'absent parents' who are far away or have very busy schedules and need someone trustworthy to take care of their child or children.

**How capable is Pamville to provide such a service?** Pamville is 'home away from home' with the necessary facilities for the



wellbeing of your child! Pamville Schools Nsangi boasts of very well established infrastructure with the necessary social services and has created other networks to meet the needs of any child. On top of that, we have very trustworthy trained and competent staff who are capable of providing the necessary care, support and love to children taking them as their own. The staff are trained in different aspects of child care and training.

### **What does Pamville Mukuuma Education Service involve?**

Children enrolled into the program will be given all the education services like those for children in boarding school. In addition, the school will provide the following;

- Medical insurance cover for the child to meet his/her health and wellbeing. Pamville staff will accompany the child to access healthcare services in case of sickness. Special needs and medical review: Any other special needs like taking the child for medical reviews, or annual medical check-up will be done accordingly.

- Welfare and social support.
  - o Shopping for the child: Pamville staff will go and buy any requirements that the parents want for their child as is agreed upon. The child will be informed about that these shopping escapades are sponsored by the parents and any items purchased will be shown to the parents.
  - o Home visits and visits to other relatives: In case of any need to visit other family members like grandparents, aunties or uncles, Pamville staff will ensure that the person approved by the parents is given to the child upon filling up the necessary forms. The child will be realised in accordance with the wishes of the parents as communicated and agreed upon.
  - o Participation in the ascribed religious activities. Pamville schools staff will ensure that the child participates in the religious activities as indicated by the



parents. The child will also be enrolled in the religious trainings like baptism, confirmation, etc as the parent wishes.

- Easy communication and engagement with your child. Pamville School will ensure that you are able to talk with your child directly on a big screen creating a sense of parental closeness and bonding. The parent can even engage with the child in doing their homework or participate in any education activities online. The time of interactions will be agreed upon with the school authorities.

- Participation in extracurricular activities. Based on the interest of the parent, the child will participate in different activities like sports activities (Swimming, Football, Netball, Ballet Dance, Skilling programs like ICT lessons, Fashion and design, Chess, among others), and other school clubs.

- Holiday support: Upon agreement with between the parents and Pamville school authorities, the child can stay with Pamville Schools Nsangi during holidays or taken to their relatives as has been instructed. The child can also be enrolled to the different holiday programmes as

instructed by the parents.

### **What does the Pamville Mukuuma Education Service cost?**

The parent will be required to pay the general tuition, school fees, uniforms, etc like any child in boarding section. In addition, the parent will pay for the medical insurance as per the premium of the insurance company contracted. The parent will pay for the based on the agreed upon he parent will provide the necessary tuition fees. **You will need to provide the following necessary documents;**

- o Child's birth certificate and Photo
  - o Mothers and fathers copy of National ID, contacts and photos
  - o At least 2 people – Child's next of kin apart from the mother and father
  - o Person responsible for paying the child's schools fees and other dues as per the program
- Put your mind at rest as you look for the livelihood of the family! Entrust us with your child through the Pamville Mukuuma Education Service.

The child is the axle of the wheel of society and our future, Once spoilt, the Society will be doomed!

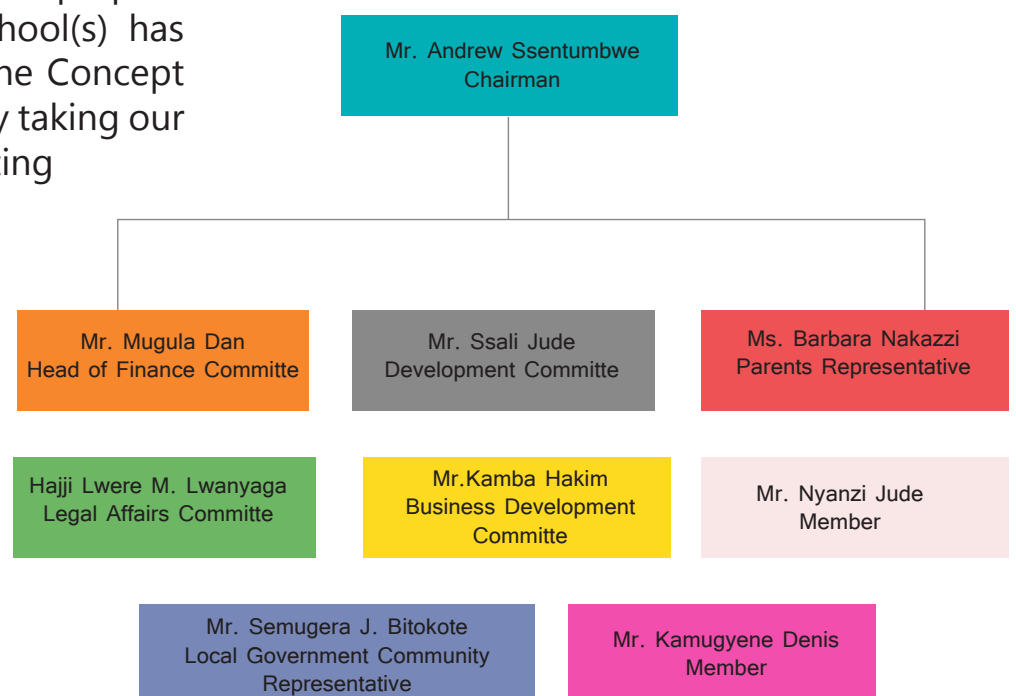
As we conclude 2023 and prepare for 2024, Pamiville School(s) has resolved to re-invent the Concept of Parenting by not only taking our parents through parenting

## Academic giants of Pamville Junior School

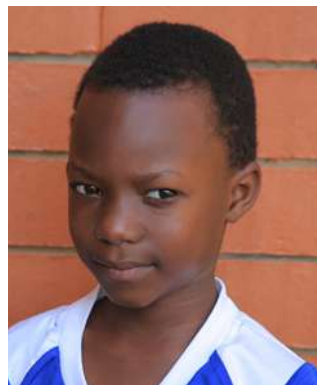

**9.** Be mindful of what children watch on Television. Limit the time children spend watching TV and engage them in household chores as well.

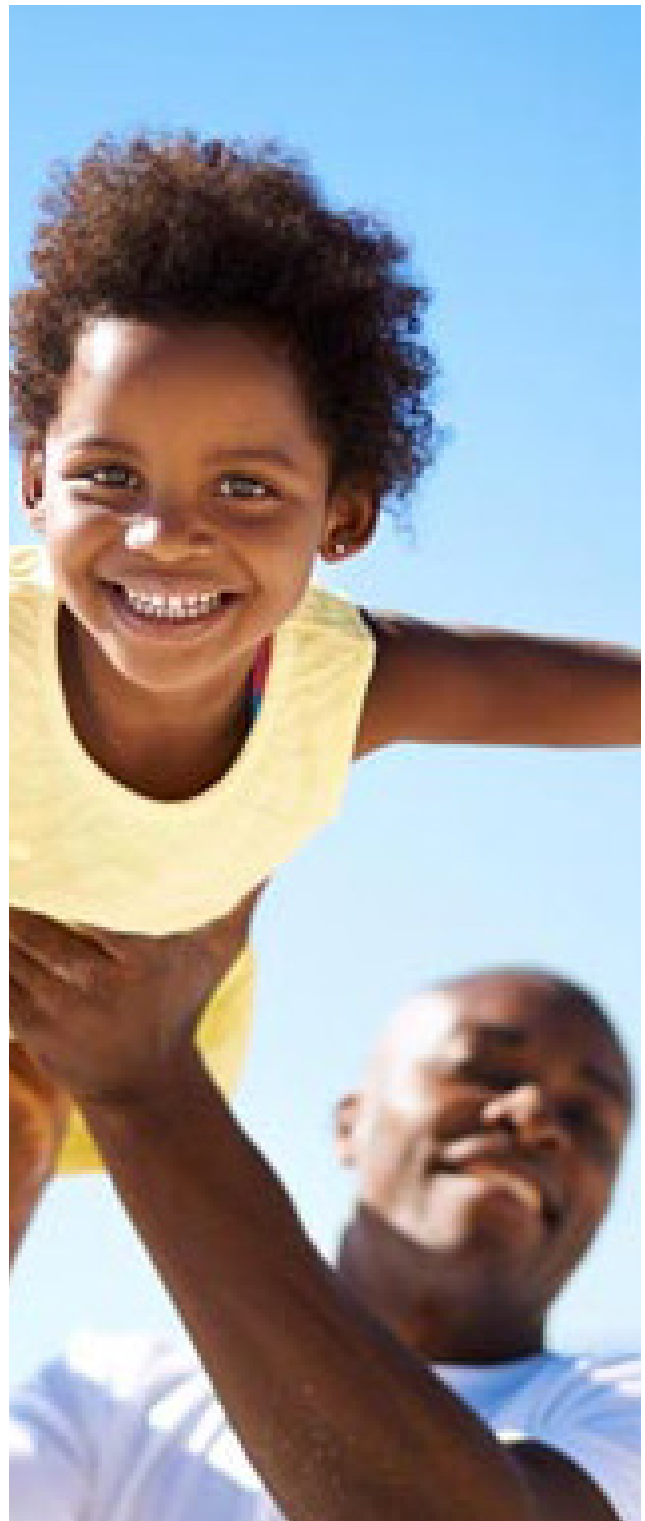
**10.** Ensure that the children get a balanced diet in order to have a break from the school menu. This helps in both the physical and cognitive development of the child.

**11.** Dress your children appropriately so that predators don't mistake them for being adults (men and women) yet they are still children. Remember that both boys and girls can be defiled.

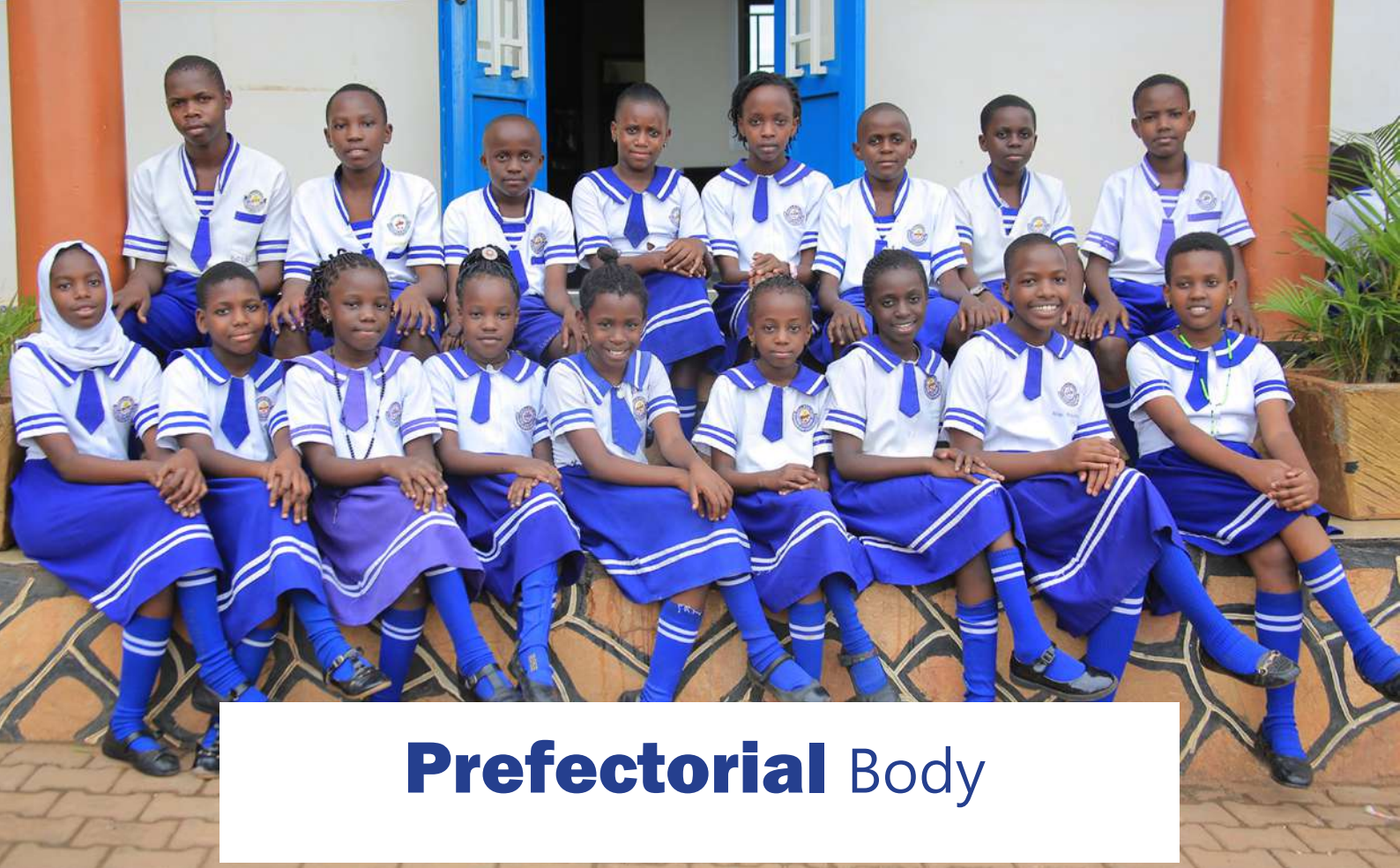
**12.** Be exemplary to your children.

## **Your health is your wealth!**

Some of the habits teens need to practice to promote their health and wellbeing

When they say “Health is Wealth” what exactly do they mean? The answer is that health is the biggest wealth anybody can have. Anything can be achieved if we have good health and our bodies are in good functioning conditions. It is not enough to have money alone, and we can make good use of wealth only if we have good health. Being healthy also saves money and time which resources can be used to get more money and wealth.

For many teens, young people and some adults too, sometimes it is not easy understanding and appreciating the importance of taking care of their health. When one is young he/she cannot think of getting numerous diseases because of the bad habits she / he is engaging in. Healthy habits for teens and young people can go a long way in helping them lead

a healthy and peaceful life in the future, whereas bad habits like poor hygiene or frequent eating of unhealthy foods like pizzas, chips, sausages, fizzy drinks like sodas, among others can be detrimental to their health. Teens and young people should be strongly advised that to be successful in their future, they need to keep themselves healthy, always being disciplined and avoiding bad (unhealthy) habits and bad groups.

Parents and guardians need to know that children pick up different habits as they grow. It is not unusual that many adolescents often are seen to have more affinity towards bad habits such as eating unhealthy diets, untimely eating, irregular sleep routines, and inappropriate screen time. So, as parents and guardians we can play a great role in ensuring healthy living of their teens, adolescents and young children. Below are some measures on how to help your teen to pick up healthy habits;

### 1. Establish healthy eating routines

Healthy eating involves making healthy food choices like eating more vegetables and fruits, and also having a regular and timely eating

pattern. You can instruct your teens to follow some of these healthy eating routines:

- Have your breakfast every day.
- Have your meals and snacks on time
- Have your meals on table along with your family, rather than gulping down food in front of TV screens or smart phones.

One psychologist

explained that, "We eat more mindlessly in front of the TV / smart phone. We also don't taste and experience the food properly because we're distracted." This distraction causes us to ignore signs that we are full, leading to overeating which can lead to gaining too much weight with negative consequences.

- Give yourself enough time to have your meals and avoid eating in a hurry.
- Make sure your teen's meal contains sufficient vegetables since they are rich in numerous nutrients and offer ample health benefits.
- Ensure your teen drinks plenty of water daily. Drinking at least eight glasses of water daily is necessary to good kidney health, good skin, and energized muscles

### 2. Incorporate physical activity into your daily life

Encouraging your teens to engage in physical activities regularly is crucial for their overall health and well-being. It has been noticed in Uganda, that there is an increase in the prevalence of obesity among children and adolescents aged 2-19 years. Always encourage your teens to walk every morning, engage in strenuous activities at home, play some

outdoor games or sports, and staying fresh and active every day. You should discourage your teen from sitting in front of the television or playing video games for many hours. You can create a timetable that allows and guides your teens and youngsters practice and engage in physical activity regularly.

### 3. Good dental hygiene

Another healthy habit for teenagers you should not forget to inculcate in them is brushing their teeth which also include flossing. Instruct your teen to brush their teeth every day before going to bed and after they wake up. Show them how to floss for one or two minutes. It will help them develop good oral hygiene. Flossing enhances the positive effects of brushing the teeth and prevents gum infections.

### 4. Establish a good sleeping routine

Following a good sleeping routine will help your teen stay fresh and fit. Encourage your teen to follow a bedtime routine in their daily schedule that helps them relax. This can include the following:

- Eating healthy and light before going to bed
- Having a bath daily
- Reading
- Listening to pleasant, relaxing music
- Going to bed at or nearly the same time every day

5. Staying away from alcohol, smoke, drugs, etc



Many teens and young people often have a tendency to get influenced by peer pressure or have the inclination to try smoking, alcohol or drug abuse. Smoking and drinking alcohol frequently can affect their health and behaviour, and such bad habits can increase the risk of one getting lung disease, stomach ailments, and other life-threatening health problems. So, educate your teens about cigarettes, drugs abuse and encourage them to stay away from smoking and alcohol.

#### 6. **Avoid spending hours online**

Several studies reveal that teens spending hours online are more vulnerable to internet addiction. Internet addiction may lead to impaired cognitive functions in adolescence and also affect

your teen's eyes adversely. So make sure your teen doesn't spend long hours online. This also includes watching TV all the time. As parents we need to watch out for what kind of on-line sites teens and youngsters visit. The problem of addiction to pornography is now seen among teens which leads to many negative consequences.

There many other bad habits which can adversely affect the health of your teen and ruin his/her future. Always let your child engaged in different activities to keep him/her healthy in body, mind and soul.

3. Better behaviour and emotional health – learners whose dads are involved in school tend to be emotionally healthier, have fewer problems with behaviour and enjoy school more.

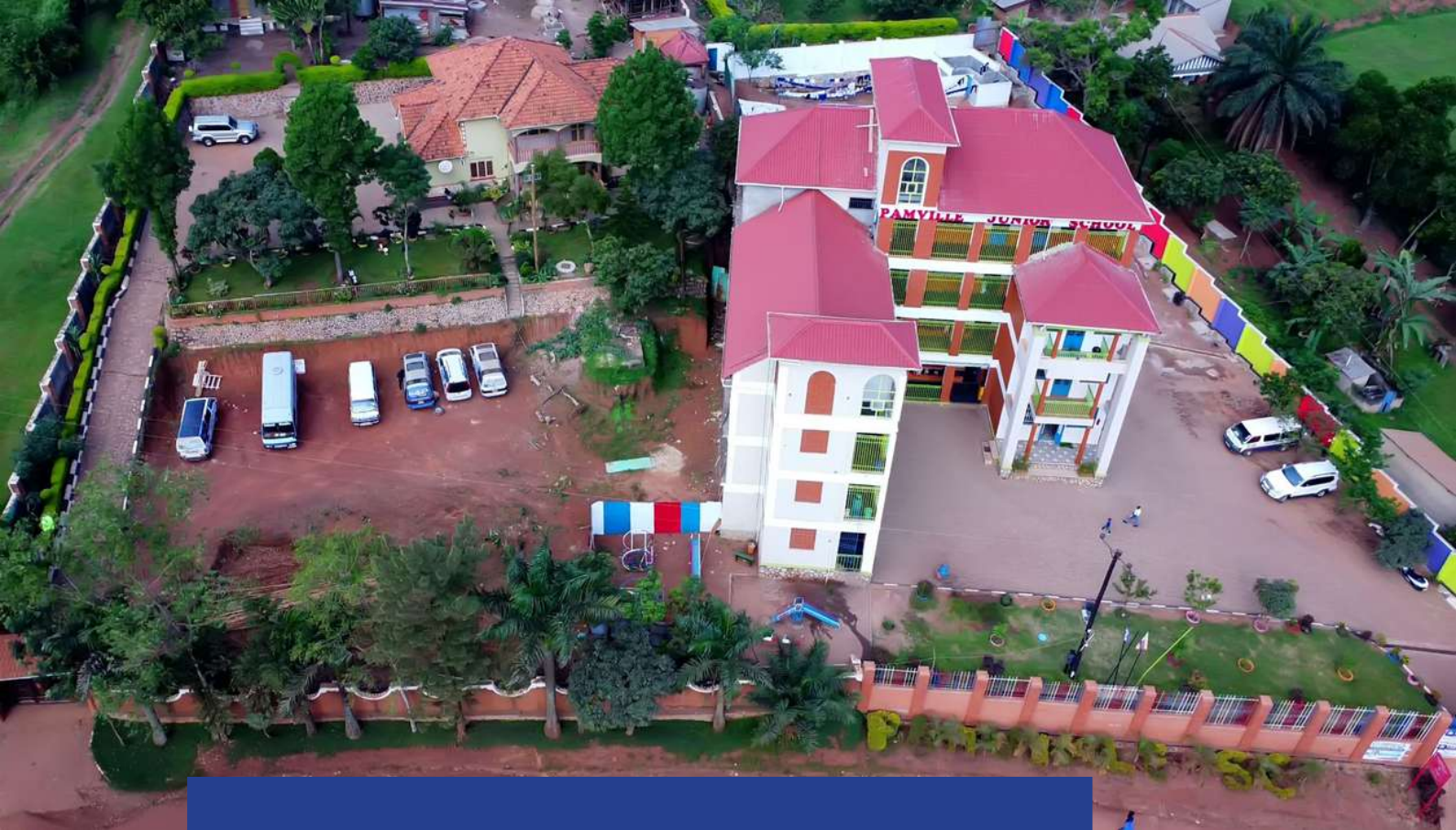
At Pamville Schools Nsangi, we are challenging all fathers that they need to;
